The 2015 Barneveld Lodge #319 Milestone Recognition Program

Most of us think of the 1950s as an easy time with rock and roll, dancing, and milk shakes. But 1950 was far from this idyllic concept. 1950 was a significant transition being only 4 1/2 years from the end of World War II. The Korean War and the threat of communism dominated 1950.

Thirty-five people attended the milestone recognition program including family members of some of those being recognized.



The four 65 year Masons



Ralph Baumeister was raised a Mason on March 3, 1950 at Grant Lodge #169. He Was Worshipful Master in Boscobel in 1955. He earned a proficiency card for the EA degree. He transferred to Barneveld in 2001. Tonight he served the lodge by being the Junior Warden.



Bob McNeill was raised a Mason on April 4, 1950. He has been a member of the Barneveld Lodge for 65 years. He is responsible for 2 dozen men becoming Masons, including his father who was raised a few months after Bob.



Neal Massey was raised a Mason on April 11, 1950. He was Worshipful Master of the Barneveld Lodge in 1957, 1979, and 1980. Neal's father and 4 uncles were Masons as is his son Vernon. Neal was commander of the Knights Templar, twice.



Anton "Sam" Arneson was raised a Mason on October 24, 1950. He was Worshipful Master at the Barneveld Lodge in 1956. He is an active member of Scottish Rite and the Shriners. He became a 33rd degree Mason in 1975 and the 1997 spring reunion of the Scottish Rite was the Sam Arneson reunion.



Robin Gilbertson was raised a Mason on June 2, 1981. Eventhough that was 34 years ago Robin received his 35 year certificate tonight. Hey Robin...How did that happen?



Mark McCutchin was raised a Mason on April 27, 1990. He was Worshipful Master in 1996 and 1997. Mark's uncle, Kreighton was Worshipful Master in 1967.

James Helgeson was raised a Mason on May 12, 1970. Jim was unable to be present to receive his 45 year certificate.
